Young (Ni/Co Resource), NSW.

Jervois Mining Limited has completed the infill drilling and assays for a "Trial Pit" at Young, EL 5571/5527. Significant intervals are tabled below.

A trial pit has been designed for this location with the intention to mine 500,000 tonnes of resource per annum over a two year period. This would yield about 3000 tonnes of contained nickel metal and about 300 tonnes of contained cobalt metal from a planned demonstration/pilot plant operation. Approvals will be sought from the various Government Departments to allow this demonstration/pilot plant operation to proceed.

Nyngan – ‘Westlynn’ (Ni/Co Resource), NSW.

Further drilling has been completed on the ‘Westlynn’ licence (EL6009). Assay results prompted an application to extend this licence to the North; (ELA 3578) ‘Summervale’ (20 units approximately 50 km<sup>2</sup>). Previous drilling gave an Indicated Resource of 16 million tonnes at 0.83% nickel and 0.06% cobalt. This resource was estimated by a former explorer. Significant intervals from the latest drilling are tabled below.
